2 different colours of gouache Some Acrylic Ink (FW recommended) Masking fluid Mixing brushes (basic - nothing fancy) Ruler (20 inch) 2 Cardboards (Size A4 or A3) Some soft coloured pencils (white, bronze or gold) Card board paper (at least 250 to 300 gsm) Cutting Mat (Size A4) Xacto Knife (with at least 1 more new blade) Calligraphy Pens (larger sizes, recommends automatics, 2 pencils stuck together) Gold Leaf (not real gold) Glue

Embossing Needles (1 or 2 medium sizes) Paper – A3 format – Examples: Black Velvet or White Arches is marvelous or Rosaspina Fabriano or Fabriano Artistico OR what you already have
